The Parrot CONFERENCE speakerphone can store up to 6,000 contacts that are automatically loaded wirelessly via *Bluetooth*-enabled mobile phones, PDAs, and laptops. It features a large, bright active-matrix TFT color display that makes its menus, settings and phone listings easy to see and read.

The Parrot CONFERENCE works with Parrot's proprietary advanced digital signal processing technology with full duplexing for clear, echofree conversations in rooms of any size. Three highly sensitive microphones provide a complete 360-degree voice pickup and a powerful 5W speaker allows all participants to be heard clearly.

Because it is truly wireless and powered by three rechargeable Lithium Ion batteries, the speakerphone can be easily moved from office

The Parrot CONFERENCE has fully integrated Internet communications (VoIP) software. And, for the 100 million $Skype^{TM}$ subscribers, the Parrot CONFERENCE comes with an integrated Skype interface so it is ready to use out of the box.

The self-contained Parrot CONFERENCE unit is lightweight and has a small footprint for convenience and easy portability. It measures about 10 inches in diameter, sits less than two inches high and weights only 22 ounces including the batteries.
